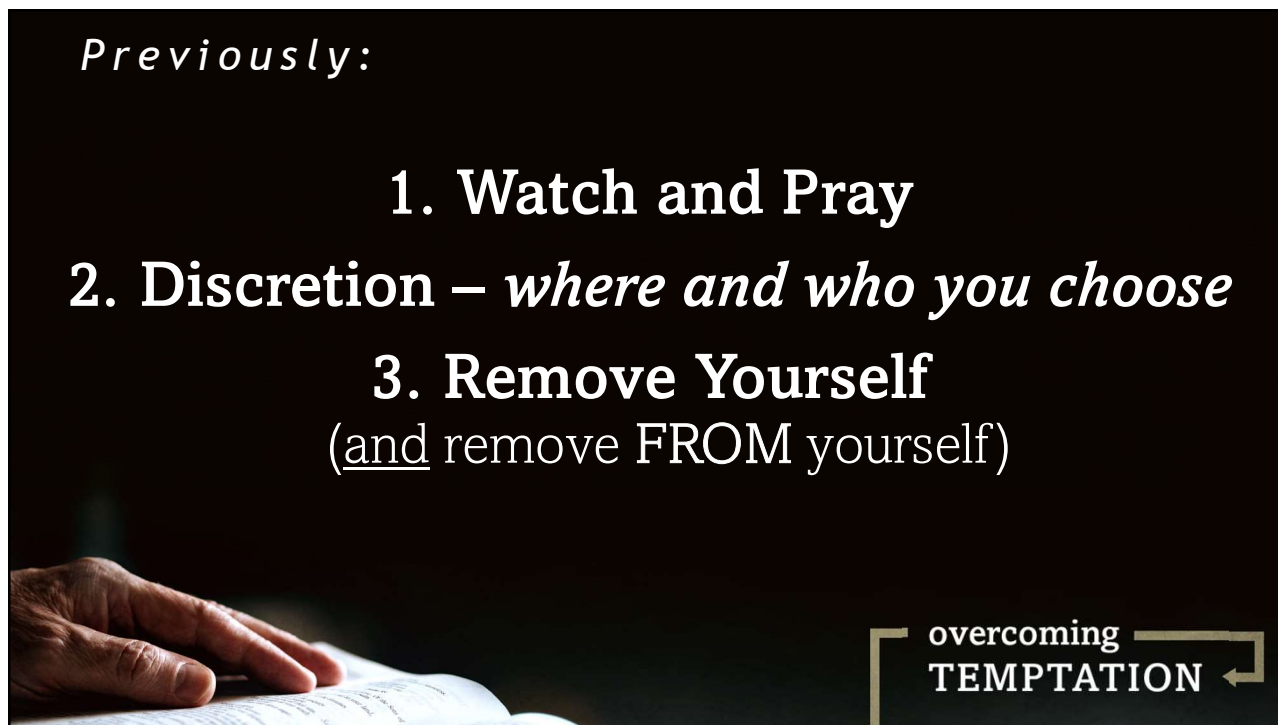

## Jesus Was Tempted In All Points

Matthew 4:1-11, tempted by the devil

**Three Channels:**

“For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world” (1 Jn. 2:16)

1. Lust of the flesh  
Make stones become bread when hungry (4:3)
2. Pride of Life  
“If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down” (4:6)
3. Lust of the eyes  
Showed Him all the kingdoms of the world (4:8)
